## **Annual Quality Assurance Report for the Academic Year 2012-2013**

### **Introduction**

The college is a place for academic excellence and wholistic approach. Our college aims at transforming the future teachers into architects of the nation. For this, we provide enough opportunities for the student-teachers and work for their integrated growth, by helping them to become intellectually competent, morally upright, psychologically mature, physically healthy and above all socially acceptable. We offer them a dynamic educational and a democratic environment with esteemed faculty and excellent educational programmes. Here we flash the triumphs of the academic year 2012 – 2013.

### **Academic Admission**

For the academic year 2012-2013, we have admitted 100 students in the B.Ed. course and 35 students in M.Ed. course respectively.

### **Results of 2011-2012**

The performance of our students for the year 2011-2012 was excellent. In the B.Ed. theory examinations 8 students got distinction and 77 secured first class and 2 in the second class; in the practical exam 33 students got distinction, 47 students secured first class and 7 in the second class. Our M.Ed. students too did well in their academics by securing 18 first class and the rest in the second class; in the dissertation 10 got distinction and 23 got first class. Over all we got 88.8% pass in the B.Ed degree course and 94.3% pass in the M.Ed degree course.

### **Academic Year Inauguration**

The College began its academic year 2012-2013 officially on 30<sup>th</sup> July 2012 with the blessings of Rev. Fr. M. Stanley Sahaya Seelan, Secretary, Bishop Agniswamy College of Education, Muttom. He insisted on the speciality of the institution and responsibilities of the student-teachers during his inaugural address.

Jasmine Sheila Burney was appointed as the Principal in the place of Dr. A. Dennis who was relieved from our college on 2<sup>nd</sup> January 2013.

### **Bridge Course**

To know the previous knowledge, communication skills and teaching aptitude of the students, bridge course was conducted from 30<sup>th</sup> July 2012 to 3<sup>rd</sup> August 2012. Mr. P. David Balasingh, Rtd. Chief Educational Officer, Mr. P. ### **Releasing of the LHJRE Journal**

Our college published a journal namely Light House Journal of Educational Reflections (LHJRE) on 3<sup>rd</sup> May 2013. It is an ISSN registered bi-annual journal of social science. The first issue of the journal was released by Most Rev. Dr. Peter Remigius, Bishop of R.C. Diocese of Kottar and received by Dr. S. Jasmine Sheila Burney, Principal of our college.

### **Exam and Evaluation**

The first and second terminal exams were conducted during September 2012 and January 2013 respectively. The first and second revision exams were conducted between 8<sup>th</sup> April 2013 and 8<sup>th</sup> May 2013.
