### Students Council Election

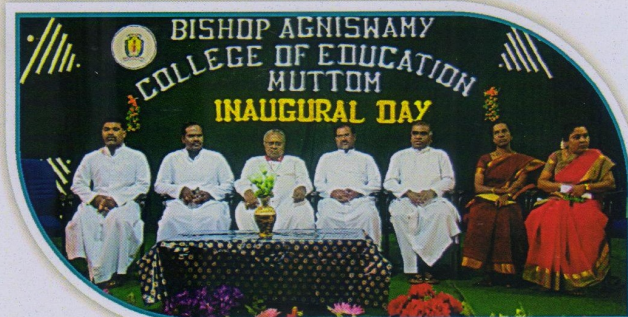

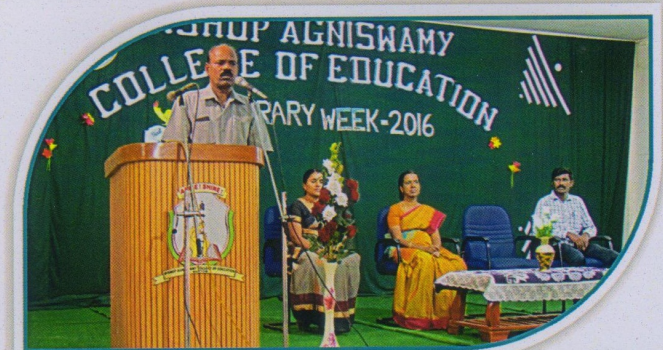


### Alumni Meeting

### Research Colloquium

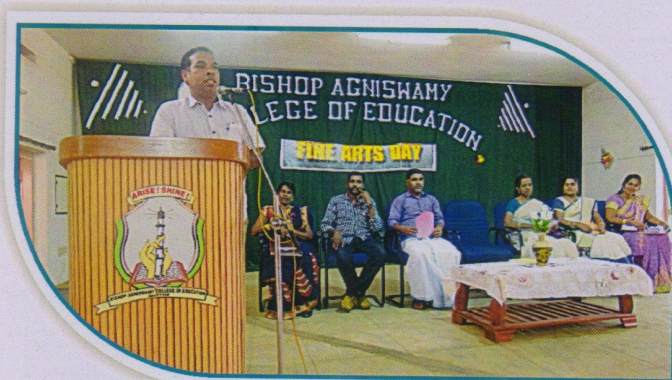
Research colloquium was arranged on 18<sup>th</sup> January 2017. Our M.Ed. students presented their research articles related to the dissertation topics.

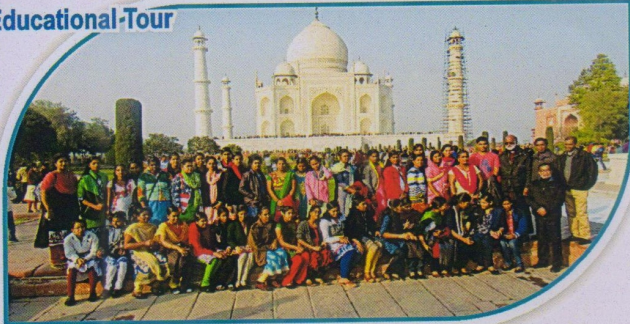

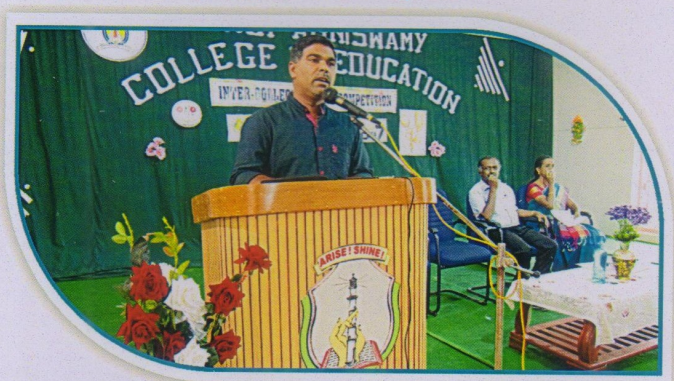
### Practical Examination

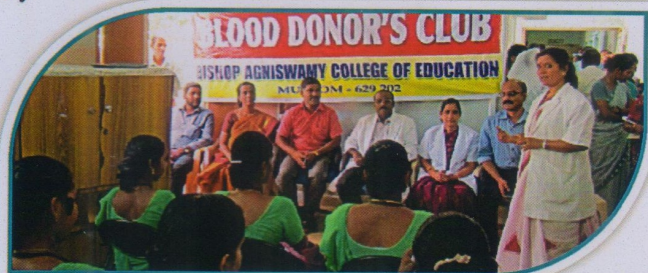


### Social Service Club

### Placement Cell

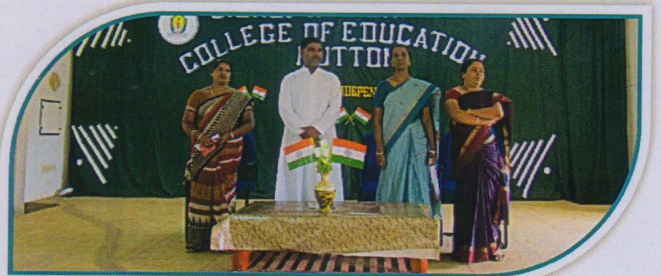

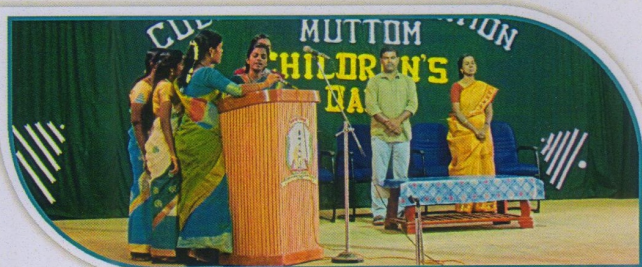


### Teacher's Day
