Inauguration of the Academic Year

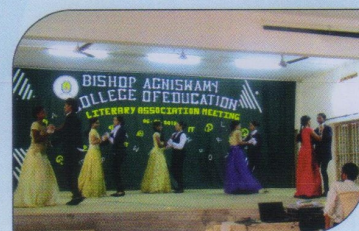
Shakespeare Club

Ramanujam and Darwin Club

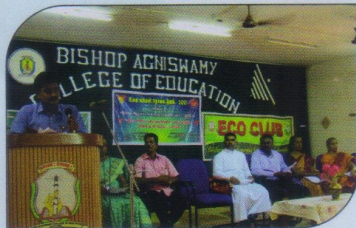

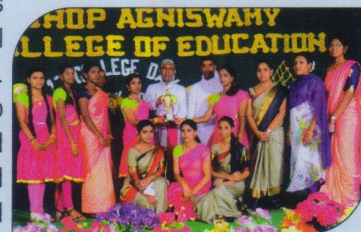
Christmas
